Senior Nutrition

People 60+ with limited mobility may be eligible for a nutritious home-delivered meal in Henderson, Mercer and Warren Counties Monday through Friday. This is not an income-based program.

Congregate meal sites are open in Aledo at the Mercer County Senior Center (M-F @ 11:30), Community Senior Citizens of Stronghurst (Mondays Only @ 11:30 AM) and Henderson Senior Center/Township Hall in Oquawka (T-TH @ 11:30 AM).

Community Marketplace

The food pantry and thrift store are located in our Community Marketplace.

Hours are Monday - Friday from 10 AM - 4 PM.

Warren County families may select free food, diapers, personal care items, and cleaning supplies.

The thrift store is open to anyone. We sell gently used goods for an affordable price. Donations are accepted Monday and Thursday from 10 AM - 4 PM with a 2 bag limit.

Recharge Teen Center

Recharge Teen Center is a safe place for local teens, ages 13 through 19, to go after school to hang out with their peers, work on homework, participate in programs and events, and access essential goods.

JCC has a fully stocked food pantry at the center, 213 S. Main St., Monmouth. Registered teens may visit the pantry as often as they would like.

School year hours are Monday-Thursday from 3 PM - 6 PM and Friday from 2 PM - 6 PM.

Weekend Meals

Six shelf-stable meals, breakfast, lunch and dinner for Saturday and Sunday, are sent home on Fridays each week during the school year for pre-k through 6th grade students in the Monmouth-Roseville School District.

Parents or children can ask a school counselor to sign up.

PLC After-School Tutoring Program

Any Warren County child in 1st - 6th grades who is 6 months to 2 years behind grade level can receive tutoring. This is not homework help. Students build fundamental skills and achieve goals in reading, writing, and math.

Tutoring sessions are Monday through Thursday, beginning after school is let out until 5 PM. Please call the number below to see if your child is eligible.

Emergency Bill Pay

Assistance is available for prescription drugs and water bills. Individuals may apply twice each year. Those using this service are asked to pay at least half of the bill. We verify the remaining balance, and mail our portion (up to \$50) directly to the provider.
