## Program Update for Spring 2025

### Food Pantry

JCC Food Pantry is located in our Monmouth Resource Center. Hours are Monday - Friday from 10 AM - 4 PM.

Families at 185% of poverty or below may select free food, diapers, and personal care items.

At the Resource Center, families with children can come every week. Households with no children can come two times per month.

### Weekend Meals

Six shelf-stable meals, breakfast, lunch and dinner for Saturday and Sunday, are sent home on Fridays each week during the school year for pre-k through 6th grade students in the Monmouth-Roseville School District.

Parents or children can ask a school counselor to sign up.

### Recharge Teen Center

JCC has a fully stocked food pantry at Eagle View Community Health System's Recharge Teen Center. We offer cooking classes. Teens, also have the opportunity to assist with the community garden.

Registered teens may visit the pantry as often as they would like.

Hours are Monday-Friday from 3 PM - 6 PM.

### Senior Nutrition

#### Home-delivered meals

People 60 and older with limited mobility may be eligible for a nutritious home-delivered meal in Henderson, Mercer and Warren Counties Monday through Friday. This is not an income-based program.

### PLC After-School Tutoring Program

Any Warren County child in 1st - 6th grade who is 6 months to 2 years behind grade level can receive tutoring. This is not homework help. Students build fundamental skills and achieve goals in reading, writing, and math.

Tutoring sessions are Monday through Thursday, beginning after school is let out until 5 PM. Please call the number below to see if your child is eligible.

### Emergency Bill Pay

Assistance, up to \$50, is available for water and prescription drugs. Individuals may apply twice each year. People using this service are asked to pay at least half of the bill. We verify the remaining balance, and mail our portion directly to the provider.
